



What is RCPP?

The Regional Conservation Partnership
Program (RCPP) promotes coordination of
NRCS conservation activities with partners
that offer value-added contributions to expand
our collective ability to address on-farm,
watershed, and regional natural resource
concerns. Through RCPP, NRCS seeks to
co-invest with partners to implement projects
that demonstrate innovative solutions
to conservation challenges and provide
measurable improvements and outcomes tied
to the resource concerns they seek to address.

Project

The goal of this project is to improve carbon sequestration, soil health, and reduce nutrient runoff while also improving profit on farms in southern Iowa by developing a Climate Smart Switchgrass Cropping System (CSSGCS). The objectives include:

 Transition 5,000 acres of sensitive traditional row crop agriculture and degraded cool season grass pastureland to native, warm-season grass, using ag management planning tools to target areas in need of soil erosion control, water quality, and profit improvements.

- Develop an alternative biomass market that could bolster local economies and provide ecological benefits.
- Increase farmer net income on targeted pasture and marginal row crop acres in project area.
- Leverage a 5-year RCPP project for conservation benefits, with a possibility of annual renewal.


